



MEMBERSHIP OF THE MERTON AND LAMBETH CAB BOARD

Before appointing a new Board Member, Merton and Lambeth CAB must ensure that the person is 'qualified to act' as a Board Member.

Some people are disqualified by law from acting as Board Members, including anyone described in section 72(1) of the Charities Act 1993. This includes:

- anyone who has an unspent conviction for an offence involving deception or dishonesty
- anyone who is an undischarged bankrupt
- anyone who has been removed from the Board of a charity by the Court or the Commissioners for misconduct or mismanagement
- anyone under a disqualification order under the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986

It is normally an offence to act as a Board Member while disqualified.
